
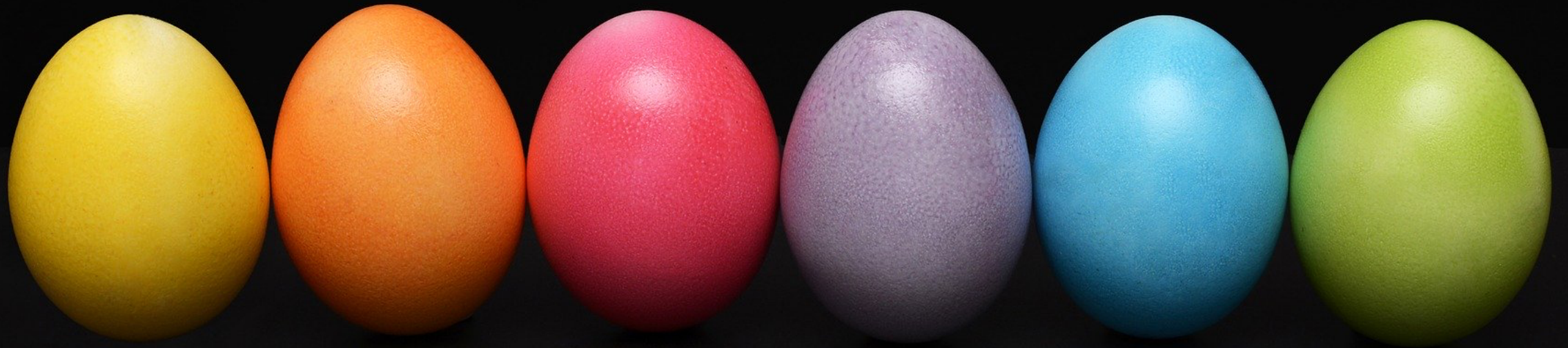

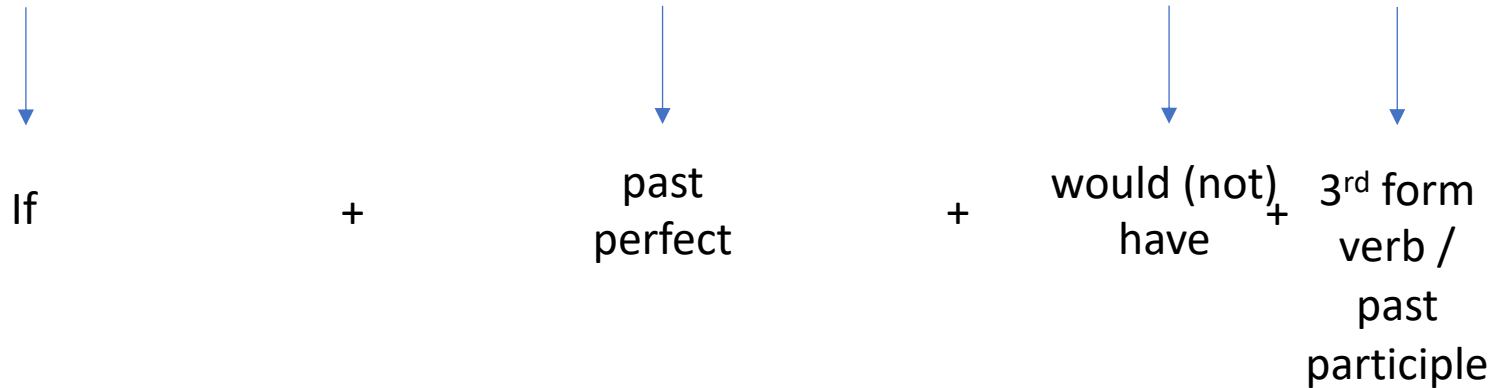
**How did the

How can you express this in English?



- 3rd conditional
- If the coronavirus had not broken out, I would have spent more time outside.



When do we use 3rd conditional?

- To talk about the past
- We talk about a condition in the past that did not happen
- We cannot change the past
- The third conditional is like a “dream”, but with no possibility of the dream coming true



Dream



- If I had won the lottery, I would have bought a Lamborghini.
- **3rd conditional**




Reality

- I did not win the lottery. I ride my bike.



More examples

- If he **had studied**, he **would have passed** the exam.
- If I **hadn't spent** so much money in my 20's, I **wouldn't have been** poor in my 30's. 
- If we **had taken** the subway, we **wouldn't have missed** the plane.
- He **would not have felt** sick if he **had not eaten** the questionable street food.
