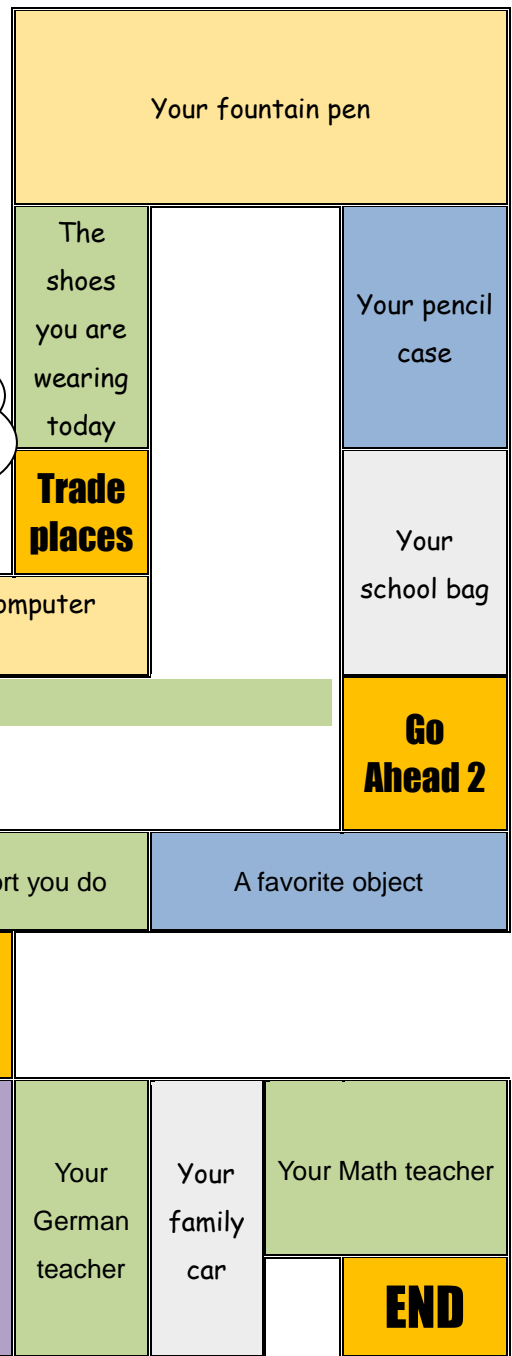


Talk about each topic or object:
Describe it...
How long have you had it...? How long have you been doing it?

You can only move your counter if you have used the correct tense.



Duration: How long have you had your?

You need: dice / counters



Throw the die and read the topic. Now talk about each topic or object:
Describe it....How long **have you had** it...? How long **have you been doing it**?
If you managed to talk about the topic and use the correct tense and use for/since correctly, you can move your counter.

You can only move your counter if you have used the correct tense.

Examples:

I **have** a cat. He **is** called Moritz. I **have had** him **for** more than **15 years**.

I **share** my room with my brother. It **is** too small. I **have shared** this room **since my brother was born**.

I **have** a big desk in my room. It **is** always messy. I **have had** this desk **for four years**.

I **can** speak English well. It **is** easy for me. I **have been learning** English **for three years**.

My best friend **is called** Mike. He **lives** next to my place and we often **play** soccer together. I **have known** Mike **since I was in primary school**

I **play** the drums. I **have been playing** the drums **for about 2 years**.
