These are my favourite 3 People from the presentations.

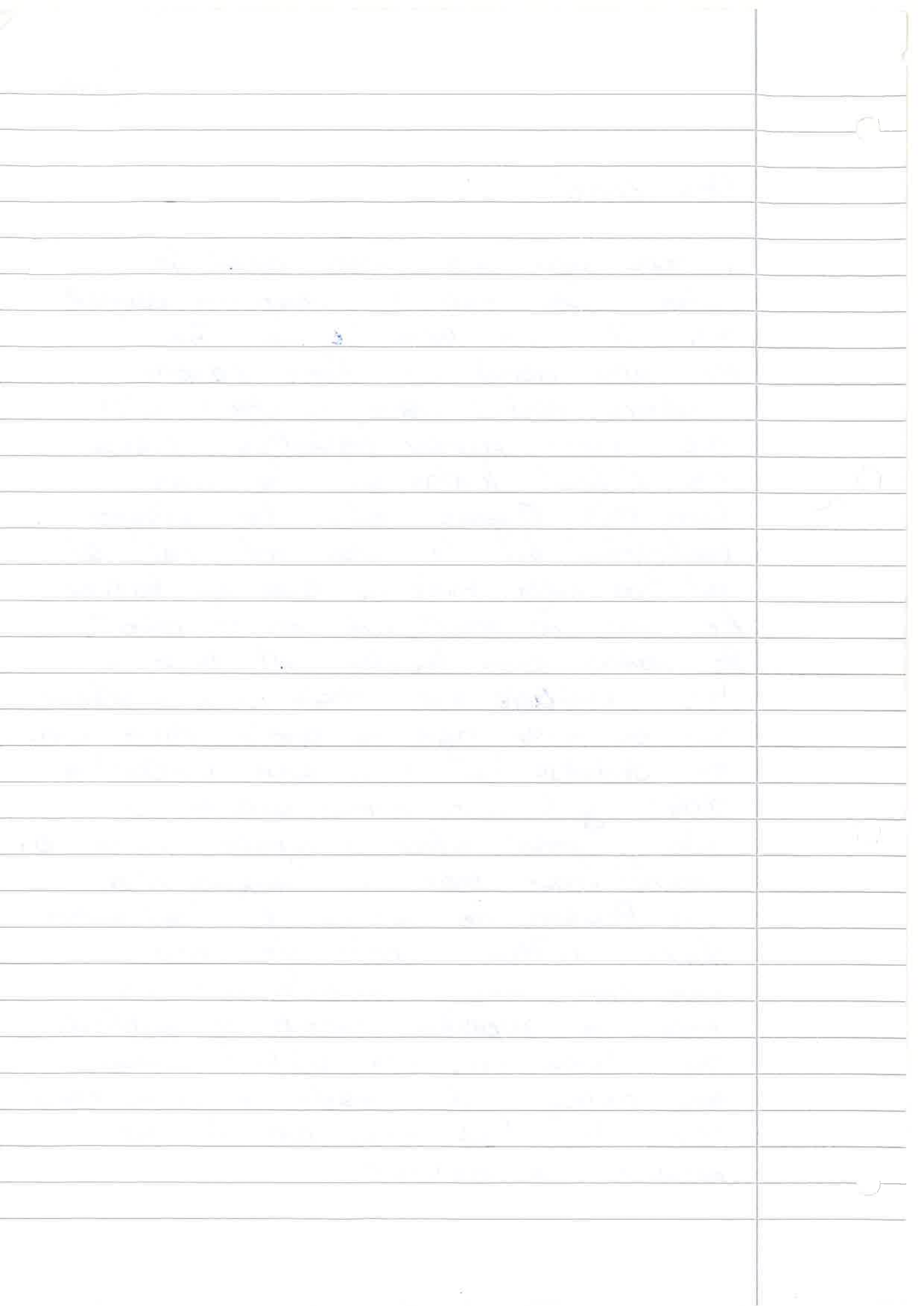

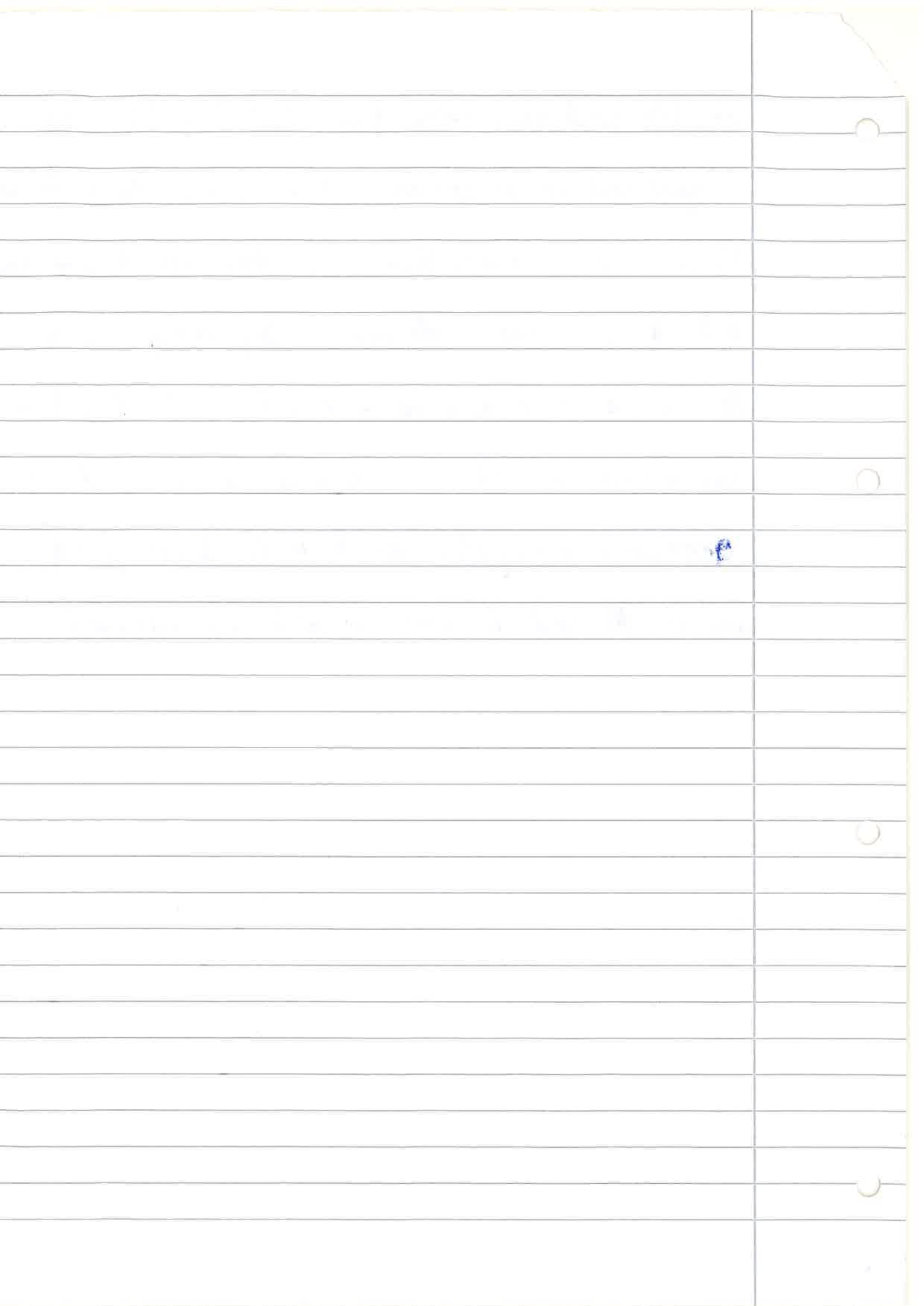
But that's not why he is ^{so} extraordinary, because many others had and have this illness, but it's very extraordinary that he worked harder.
