The tallest buildings in the world get higher and higher

Burj Khalifa: The Burj Khalifa is the highest building in the world since 2009. They began to build this skyscraper in 2004. First the building was called Burj Dubai, but they renamed it in honour to the president of the United Arab Emirates, Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Burj Khalifa. The building was designed by the architect Adrian Smith, an international architect. Of course, such a high building costs a lot. The Burj Khalifa cost about 1.5 billion US\$.

Jeddah Tower: The Jeddah Tower is a skyscraper construction in Jeddah, that's in Saudi Arabian. It should be the first one kilometre high building in the world, but in January 2018 they stopped building. They wanted to start building again in 2020, but because of the Covid-19 Pandemic they couldn't start. After the pandemic they want to start building again. The tower was only 256 metres high when they stopped building. To build the Jeddah Tower they needed a total amount of 1.23 billion US\$ till now.

Dubai Creek Tower: It was expected that the Dubai Creek Tower is finished in the year 2022, but because of the Covid-19 pandemic it is not clear when the building is finished. On the fourth April 2020 they stopped building the tower, because of the pandemic. The goal for the height of this tower is clear, it should be the highest building in the world. So, the tower will be at least 828 metres high (height of the Burj Khalifa), but the height could be about 1300 to 1400 metres too, that isn't fixed yet.
