

# The HAVE YOU EVER game:

This is a lying game. Play it in groups of 4. If possible, play it with a teacher or a student teacher (or with Angela or Clyde)

Let's find out who is lying and who is saying the truth.

Are you a good liar?

Make 2 teams.

Team A: Pick up a verb card and ask a "Have you ever" question with this verb.

**Example:** make: -- made -- **Have you ever made a fire?**

One player from team B MUST answer: **Yes, I have.** (You must always answer with YES -- even if it is not true.)

Then the players from team A must ask 3 follow-up questions. Tip: Use the question words: where, when, who, what, how, why...

**For example:**

Team A: **Where did you make the fire?**

Team B: **In my garden.**

Team A: **Why did you make a fire?**

Team B: **Because we wanted to grill sausages.**

Team A: **Who was with you when you made the fire?**

Team B: **My whole family. It was on my birthday.**

Now team A decides if the player from Team B has said the truth.

**For example:**

**I think it's true.**

OR

**I think it isn't true.**

If team A is right, they get a point.

Now Team B picks up a verb card and asks a "HAVE YOU EVER" question.
