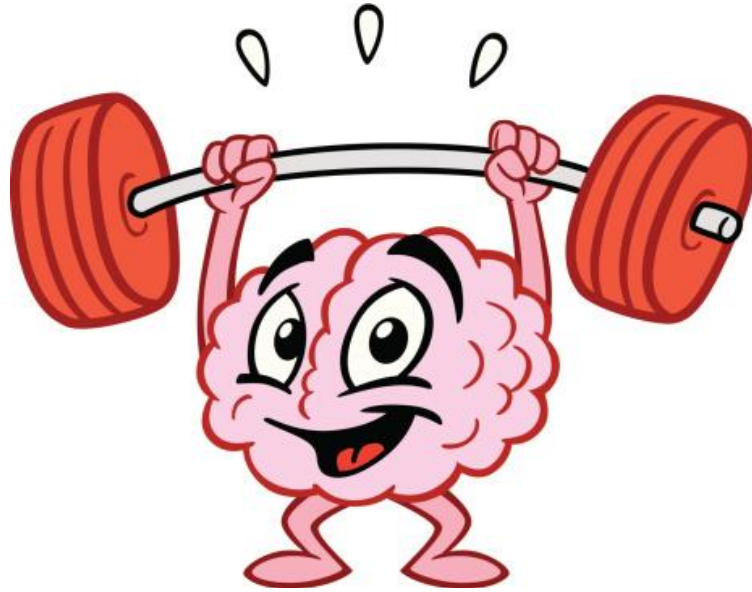


Stretch your Memory
