# THE HAUNTED HOUSE

- \* Is there a history of murder or violent crime in the house?
- \* Have the previous owners gone insane?
- \* Do you feel like you are being watched?
- \* Is the house infested with bats, spiders, and mice?
- \* Does the piano start playing on its own?
- \* Do the lights turn on or off when nobody is in the house?
- \* Are there blood stains on the carpets, walls, or ceiling?
- \* Do animals fear going inside the house?
