Justifications**0/D**

Kimberly says, "I heard of the audition from friends and from family and they all told me to go there, but I wasn't really motivated, but then I went there just for fun. ... I wasn't really satisfied and the judges were very strict, but I got further and I improved at every round."

The correct answer is **D (she just wanted to see if she could succeed).**

A is not correct because there is no indication that her mother wanted her to do so.

B is not correct because Kimberly says that she was not very motivated to go there.

C is not correct because there is no indication that it has been her dream since she was little.

Q1/B

Kimberly says, "the semi-finalists were all taken to Vienna... and then the judges personally told each and everyone if they were in the show or not."

The correct answer is **B (they had been successful).**

A is not correct because the singers did not stay in Vienna after the third round, they only were taken there.

C is not correct because Kimberly does not refer to "looks".

D is not correct because the judges did not work with the contestants, but they informed them about their success.

Q2/C

Kimberly says the contract "was a stack of 200 pages....for example, we were not allowed to ski or do any other sport during the timeframe where the show was, because, you know, nothing was supposed to happen to us".

The correct answer is **C (had to avoid risking an injury).**

A is not correct because the Starmaniacs were only shocked when they saw the contract, but did not regret taking part in the show.

B is not correct because Kimberly never mentions "returning home".

D is not correct because Kimberly never mentions that speaking about the contract was a secret.

Q3/A

Kimberly says, "During the timeframe of the show we got our hotels (rooms) all for ourselves and all the costs for food or transportation were paid for". So the contestants were offered free accommodation, free meals and free transport.

The correct answer is **A (free accommodation).**

B is not correct because Kimberly does not mention "a personal assistant".

C is not correct because although Kimberly mentions transport that was paid for, she does not mention that a car took the contestants to the studio.

D is not correct because Kimberly does not mention "trendy clothes".

Q4/C

Kimberly says, "At the hotel I had... new experiences, for example there were even photographs taken when I came out of the hotel in my pyjamas. ...and they always watched out if we were doing bad things and see where we were going out just to see that they get something in the media".

The correct answer is **C (appeared in their nightclothes)**.

A is not correct because Kimberly only mentions that the press observed them where they were going out to or if they were doing bad things. She does not mention drinking.

B is not correct because Kimberly only mentions that the press observed them where they were going out to, not when they came back from clubbing.

D is not correct because Kimberly does not mention any fights.

Q5/B

Kimberly says, "The week itself always started with the selection of our song."

The correct answer is **B (the choice of a new song)**.

A, C and D are not correct because Kimberly speaks of these things as being the daily routine and not the start of the week.

Q6/C

Kimberly says, "One day before the show we always had our stage practice where also people could watch. And after that we had our last and biggest autograph session where even I saw people crying because they were so desperate to get our autographs."

The correct answer is **C (realized how desperate fans were to get signatures)**.

A is not correct because although it was a big autograph session, Kimberly does not mention any numbers.

B and D are not correct because Kimberly does not refer to "personal friends" nor to "photographers" at this stage.

Q7/A

Kimberly says, "our last run-throughs were actually about 2 hours before the show and then we got our make-up done and our costumes ready and the show was ready to start."

The correct answer is **A (get made up and dressed)**.

B is not correct because they gave autographs to the audience the day before.

C is not correct because they had decided on the song at the beginning of the week.

D is not correct because Roman, the judge, is not mentioned.

Q8/B

Kimberly says, "I... was very nervous before the performance... . But, I myself, as soon as I am on stage, as soon as I sing my first word, it's all gone and I just enjoy my performance"

The correct answer is **B (beginning to sing)**.

A, C and D are not correct because Kimberly stated the moment she no longer was nervous quite clearly.

Q9/C

Kimberly says, "in school the kids line up in front of my classroom, around the corner, for meters and meters, just to have my autograph".

The correct answer is **C (still giving souvenir signatures)**.

A is not correct because Kimberly doesn't mention teachers.

B is not correct because Kimberly looks back on Starmania and think it was a great experience.

D is not correct because nothing is back to normal. Kimberly is still a kind of star at her school.

Task 2: Brian Eno on Singing

Justifications

Q10/I

The speaker says, "So we started a weekly a capella group with just four members."

Therefore the correct answer is **J (meet once a week)**.

Q11/F

The speaker says, "Now the group has ballooned to around 15 or 20 people."

Therefore the correct answer is **G (15 members and more)**.

Q12/C

The speaker says, "I believe that singing is the key to [...] a better sense of humor."

Therefore the correct answer is **C (become more humorous)**.

Q13/E

The speaker says, "When you sing with a group of people, you learn how to subsume yourself into a group consciousness because *a capella* singing is all about the immersion of the self into the community. That's one of the great feelings—to stop being me for a little while, and to become us."

Therefore the correct answer is **E (create a sense of belonging)**.

Q14/H

The speaker says, "Well here's what we do in an evening: We get some drinks, some snacks, some sheets of lyrics and a strict starting time."

Therefore the correct answer is **I (have something to eat and drink)**.

Q15/G

The speaker says, "You want songs that are word-rich, but also vowel-rich because it's on the long vowels sounds of a song [...] that's where your harmonies really express themselves."

Therefore the correct answer is **H (have a lot of vowels)**.

Q16/B

The speaker says, "It's thrilling when you get the rhythm of something right and you all do a complicated rhythm together. So when 16 or 20 people get that dead right together at a fast tempo that's very impressive."

Therefore the correct answer is **B (manage a difficult rhythm)**.

Justifications

The speaker says "most of us believe that gladiators were prisoners of war or criminals."

Therefore the correct answer is **criminals**.

Q17

The speaker says "most of us think that all gladiator bouts finished with at least one of them dying".

Therefore the correct answer is **at least**.

Q18

The speaker says "at the very beginning gladiators fought to the death at Etruscan funerals to be bodyguards for the deceased person".

Therefore the correct answer is **bodyguards**.

Q19

The speaker says "in 107 AD the Emperor Trajan celebrated a triumph with 5,000 pairs of gladiators".

Therefore the correct answer is **10,000** or **5,000 pairs of**.

Q20

The speaker says "the spectators could buy special souvenir glass cups embossed with the names of their favorite gladiators".

Therefore the correct answer is **glass cups** or **special souvenirs**.

Q21

The speaker says "Gladiatorial bouts finished early in the 5th century for a few reasons, including the opposition of Christians and the great costs involved".

Therefore the correct answer is **the great costs involved** or **the high costs involved**.

Q22

The speaker says "There were seven main classes of gladiators distinguished by the weapons they used or their method of fighting".

Therefore the correct answer is **the weapons they used**.

Q23

The speaker says "they were attracted by the money and the lifestyle, for example, the favours of society women".

Therefore the correct answer is **the lifestyle** or **the favo(u)rs of society women**.

Q24

The speaker says "on average they fought only two or three times each year".

Therefore the correct answer is **2-3 times**.

Q25

The speaker says "gladiators had their own very brutal and very strict rules".

Therefore the correct answer is **brutal** or **violent**.

Q26

The speaker says "gladiator bouts were more like a sophisticated entertainment version of martial arts. They were closer to modern choreographed TV wrestling than wild melees".

Therefore the correct answer is **TV wrestling** or **martial arts**.

Justifications

The speaker says that the painting she is going to describe “has to be among sort of the top ten tourist attractions of the museum....”.

Therefore the correct answer is **top tourist attraction**.

Q27

The speaker says that Leutzer’s painting “ shows Washington crossing the Delaware in a boat with a great number of his troops, the actual number 2500 ... as their leading commander on Christmas Night in 1776...”.

Therefore the correct answer is **and his troops**.

Q28

The speaker says that Washington and his troops were crossing the river during a storm therefore “the troops were at this point ... demoralized , debilitated by winter...””. The test takers are asked to describe in which condition Washington and his troops were.

Therefore the correct answer is **were demoralized**.

Q29

The speaker says that “Washington led a single battalion of officers across the Delaware with horses, you can see in the background of the painting, in separate boots ... had to be a different kind of carrier to go across the water... and Henry Knox in a separate boot...”.

Therefore the correct answer is **in separate boats**.

Q30

The speaker says “ that you can almost hear his (Henry Knox’s voice) big loud voice booming across the river at the night that they crossed...”.

Therefore the correct answer is **hear his loud voice**.

Q31

The speaker says that Leutzer painted “ in Leutzer’s Düsseldorf studio .. he used studio mates and friends, you may see a tinge of Germanic heritage on some of the faces on the men ...most of the models for the various people in the boat would have been Leutzer’s German friends at the time...”.

Therefore the correct answer is **were models for**.

Q32

The speakers says that Leutzer worked with “ he used for Washington’s head the life mask ... and Leutzer got the uniform from the Smithsonian...”.

Therefore the correct answer is **life mask (of Washington)**.

Q33

The speaker says that “... for the figure of Washington he had very good, detailed information to go on....”.

Therefore the correct answer is **good, very detailed information.**

Q34

The speaker says that “he (Leutzer) chose to portray the American flag He tried as hard as he could to make it as accurate as possible.”

Therefore the correct answer is **as accurate as possible.**
