A Century of Smoking

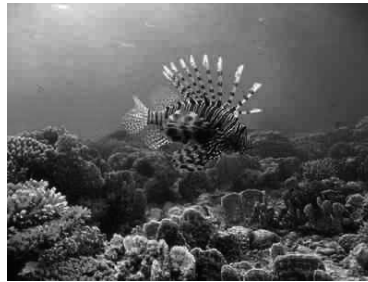

Sherlock Holmes
