
1. Read the text and make sure you understand all the language.

2. Sum up the information in exactly 100 words.

3. Select/highlight 16 chunks of language that you would like to remember.

4. Copy the 16 chunks on a 4x4 grid. (Use an A4 sheet, fold it into a 4x4 template)

5. Fold a second A4 sheet and try to express each of your phrases in a simple drawing or sketch.

6. Cut the two sheets into 16 cards each.

7. Use these cards to play "Go Fish" (Memory).

8. Swap cards with another pair and see if you can match their phrases with the right pictures.

9. Record your phrases in your vocab book so you can revise them at a later point.

10. Homework: Letter to the editor (Leserbrief)

Write a letter to the editor. Imagine you are one of the low-paid employees. You can hardly make ends meet. Complain about the situation and suggest possible solutions or measures.
