Superstitions

Many superstitions go back to a long time ago. Sometimes history can explain them. For example, if you see a black cat, you will have bad luck. This is because long ago people believed in witches who had black cats, and people thought everything about witches was bad. Bats were also the pets of witches, so that explains the superstition we have today: if you see bats flying and you hear their noise, something terrible will happen to you.

Here's another superstition with a history. In Roman times people didn't have mirrors. They looked at themselves in pools of water. They believed they could see very deeply into themselves that way. But it was bad luck to throw a stone into the pool and 'break' the 'picture' of themselves. People still say you will have seven years of bad luck if you break a mirror. Many groups of people have superstitions that have a special meaning for them. Actors are one example. One of the superstitions is about Macbeth, one of Shakespeare's most famous plays. If anyone says the name Macbeth, then the actors will have bad luck and the play will not go well.

There's another superstition about the theatre. Actors usually don't like having three candles on the stage. This is a very old superstition: that if there are three candles in a room, the person nearest to the shortest candle will die first. Actors never wish each other 'good luck' before a performance because it will bring bad luck. That's why we always tell actors to 'break a leg.' It sounds negative, but we are really wishing them all the best! Another group of people who are very superstitious are sailors*. This is because in the past, sailors were afraid of the ocean and the long, dangerous journeys they had to make. So they had lots of superstitions to keep bad luck away. They didn't put their left foot down first when they walked onto a ship, they didn't throw stones into the sea from a ship, and they never started sailing on a Friday!

But they believed that if you see dolphins swimming, you will have good luck on your journey. There are also lots of sportsmen who have their own superstitions. The great basketball hero Michael Jordan always wore his old shorts under his basketball clothes for good luck during a match. The golfer Tiger Woods believes that if he wears red on Sundays, he will be lucky. Liverpool football players like to touch the Liverpool sign as they run onto the football field to play. Chelsea ex-player Eidur Gudjohnsen always kisses his shirt twice (for two goals) before a match!
