<p>whole class:</p> 	<p>We watch a short <u>video clip with various animals</u> Which animals do you remember?</p> <p><u>Animal Guessing Game:</u> Guess the animal before the time runs out!</p>		
<p>pair work</p> 	<p><u>Speaking activity:</u> Have you got a pet? -> you will get the prompt cards from your teacher</p> <p>Students work in pairs and ask questions about their pets. Find out which pet your partner has!</p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Worksheet plural forms:</u> Tick the correct article (a/an) and write the words in the plural.</p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Worksheet animals + plural forms:</u> 1) write down the names of the animals under the pictures 2) write the plural form next to the animal</p>		
<p>whole class</p>	<p>Together we  collect many different adjectives to describe animals and write them on the board</p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Animal adjectives:</u> Write down many adjectives (at least 5) that describe a specific animal. Choose 7 different animals! Pimp your entries with drawings.</p>		
<p>teamwork or individual work</p> 	<p><u>Worksheet animal habitats:</u> Fill the bubbles with your ideas. Afterwards <u>we go</u> through the worksheet together</p>		
<p>Teamwork with changing partners</p>	<p><u>Speaking activity:</u> Guess my animal! A: Describe an animal by using only 3 adjectives and telling where it lives. For example: My animal is hairy and big and strong and it lives in the desert. B: Guess the animal</p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Reading comprehension worksheet:</u> Read the texts and find the matching animal. Highlight at least five words you don't know!</p>		

<p>whole class:</p> 	<p><u>Power point presentation: body parts</u> <u>We collect some useful expressions on the board</u></p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Running dictation</u>: read a passage on the wall, walk or run back. Write down what you can remember.</p> <p>Add two extra sentences (per pet) to your texts. I will correct them in class.</p>		
<p>Group of 3-4</p> 	<p><u>Flashcard game Go Fish</u>: Players try to form sets of three-of-a-kind. Winner is the player who makes the most sets.</p> <p>Students each get 2 or 3 cards dealt to them. Going clockwise students try to match up their cards by asking other students if they have a matching card.</p>		
<p>individual work</p> 	<p><u>Fun activity</u>:</p> <p>Draw a <i>one eyed one horned flying purple people eater!</i> Afterwards <u>we</u> watch the video clip and find out what this purple people eater looks like.</p>





Children write the collection of adjectives in their exercise book. They are encouraged to pimp their entries with drawings.












Worksheet animal habitats: We need this vocabulary as a basis for a discussion about animals.

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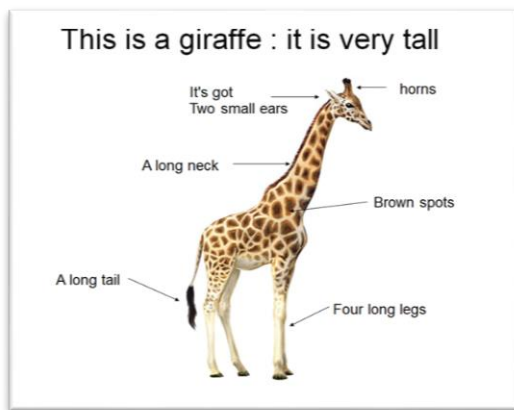
