

Present Perfect - Time Expressions

This activity looks at the idea that certain time expressions usually appear with the present perfect.

A student draws a card and must make a sentence or question using the time expression.

The other students judge and suggest improvements or corrections.

Afterwards, the teacher writes all the time expressions on the board and has the students write down a different present perfect sentence for each time expression.



twice	for	never	lately
once	recently	yet	already
just	ever	since	three times
