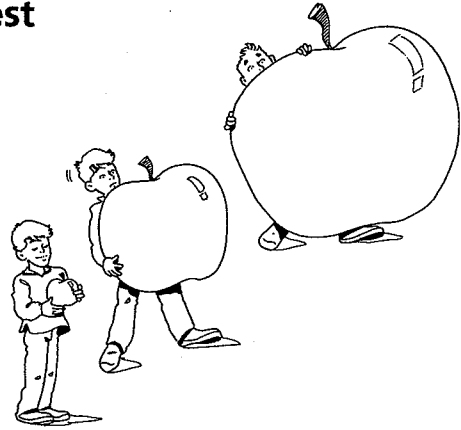

2/3 2/8 Board game: funny – funnier – the funniest

FUNNY – FUNNIER – THE FUNNIEST
Rules

This is a game for two or three players.

For this game you need:

- a counter for each player
- a dice
- the board
- the key



All the players put their counters on START. The tallest player throws the dice first and moves her/his counter as many spaces as there are dots on the dice.

If she/he lands on a square with a word on it, e.g. big, she/he must say the comparative and the superlative forms of the adjective: bigger – the biggest.

If she/he lands on a square with animals on it, she/he must compare them, e.g.: She/he lands on the square with the elephant and the butterfly.

So she/he says: An elephant is stronger than a butterfly. A butterfly is not as strong as an elephant.

If the comparatives or sentences are not correct, the player must go back to the square where she/he came from. The players look at the key when they don't know if an answer is correct or not. The winner is the person who gets to FINISH first.
