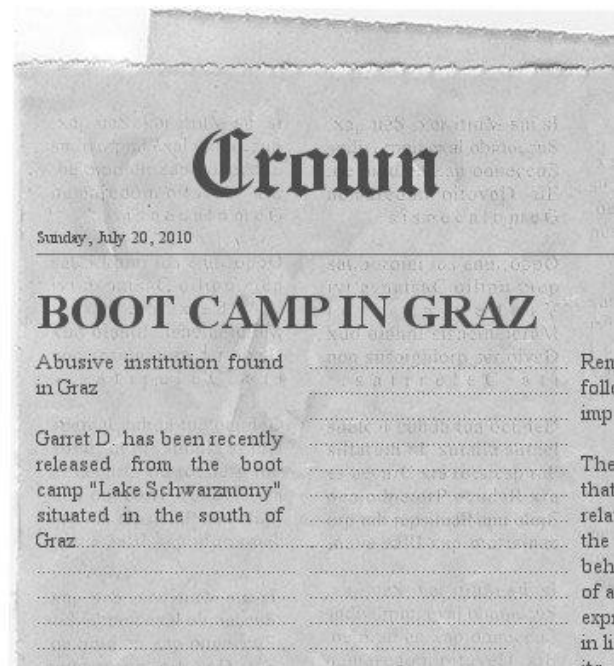
Station 5 – Newspaper snippet
