# Ice Cream



Finally, the winter is over! Now it's summer time, but why are we talking about ice again? Everybody loves a cold ice cream on hot summer days. In this article you can learn how to make your own ice cream. The ALL you need team also asked two people about their favourite ice cream. You should really should read this text if you want to know a little bit more about ice cream.

## Ice Cream Recipe

You can create your own ice cream. All you need are some pieces of fruit (maybe different kinds), yoghurt (200ml), cream (200ml) and sugar (you can also add other things like chocolate, nuts, ...). It is important that your tools and your ingredients are cold. There are different ice cream machines that make the process of ice cream making easier, but you can also make ice cream without an ice cream machine. Let's start:

1. First you put the fruits, the yoghurt and the other ingredients into a mixer.
2. After that you start mixing. It is still important that your bowl and mixer are cold. Whisk the mixture slowly until it gets hard to mix. (it takes for about 15min. - 30min.)
3. Now the mixture should be a bit stiffly (in the picture you can see it). Now you can fill the mixture into little bowls. In the small bowls you can garnish them with fresh fruits.

# Sweden




**What is the most traditional food of Sweden? What is the capital city of Sweden? How long does it take to go from Vienna to Stockholm by airplane? And which animals can you find in the nature there? I will answer all these questions in this text for you. Have fun reading it!**

 *The most traditional food* of Sweden is Köttbullar (meatballs). The Swedish eat them with a special sauce (which is made of veal **stock<sup>1)</sup>** and cream), mashed potatoes and cranberry jam. I've already eaten them and they tasted delicious!



 *The capital city* of Sweden is Stockholm. Stockholm is a very beautiful city. The Queen of Sweden lives in Stockholm. You can visit the **treasure house<sup>2)</sup>** in the Queen's old castle and also the new royal family's castle. In Stockholm there are many very cool museums like ABBA the Museum, the Vasa-Museum (that's a huge ship) or the Butterfly House.

 *From Vienna to Stockholm* it takes one and a half hours by plane.

 You can find many *elks* in Sweden. They are really big and can weigh up to 800 kg and their maximal shoulder height is 2,30m. Elks often get run over of cars because they are well camouflaged in the dark winter and car drivers don't see the Elks. This is also dangerous for the car drivers. Most accidents happen in the spring because this is the time in which the young elks leave their mothers. 4000 to 5000 elks per year have to die because of car accidents.

### HOW TO MIX IT:

FIRST YOU PUT THE ICE CUBES INTO THE BOWLE. THEN CUT THE FRUITS INTO LITTLE PIECES AND PUT THEM INTO THE BOWLE. FILL IN THE FRUITE JUICE, THE ICE WATER AND ONE DASH OF THE DARK SIRUP.



# Brazil

Why is Brazil called Brazil? What sights can I see there? What is the Copacabana? How does a Brazilian dish taste? If you want to know these questions you should read this text. It tells you important information about the country, but also something about the sights and on the end of the page you can find a Brazilian Recipe that you can try!!! Have fun reading about Brazil.

The country Brazil got the name from a special kind of wood: (Paul-Brasil) the Brazil wood or Queenwood. The flag is mostly green. On the green is a yellow **lozenge shape** and in it is a blue circle. First the green color did not stand for the jungle and the yellow did not stand for the natural resources. It was meant for the house **Braganza** (green) and for the Habsburger (yellow). Many people think Rio is the capital city of Brazil, but this is wrong it is Brasilia.



## Christ the Redeemer

It is a famous statue of Jesus Christ. The statue is in Rio de Janeiro. Christ the Redeemer is about 30m high and his arms are about 28m stretched out. It is made of soapstone and **concrete** and its weight is around 635 tonnes. It is a sign for the Christianity of Brazil.



## Iguacu Falls

The Iguacu Waterfalls consists of around 20 big waterfalls and many small ones. Some of them are about 80 meters high, but most of



them are approximately 60 metres high. Some waterfalls are in Brazil but most of them are in Argentina. If you want to you can have a walk along the side of the canyon.

## Sugarloaf Mountain

In Portuguese, the 395 metres high mountain is called Pao de acucar mountain. The Sugarloaf Mountain and the Christ Redeemer are the landmarks of Rio de Janeiro. In 1912 a glass walled cable car was build that leads up to the peak. Now you can also take it.



## Copacabana:

It is a waterfront of Rio de Janeiro. It is very famous for the four kilometre long sand beach. On the beach there are often big presentations where about 1 million people come to visit. For example: on the 28<sup>th</sup> July (2013), pope Franziskus celebrated the church service at the Copacabana beach at the end of the 28<sup>th</sup> world youth day. 3.2 million people were celebrating with him.



**Ingredients:**

**2 cups of rice**

**1 cup of water**

**3 tablespoons of milk**

**1 egg**

**¼ cup of chopped onion**

**1 chopped scallion**

**2 tablespoons of chopped parsley**

**1 teaspoon of backing powder**

**4 tablespoons of grated parmesan**



### **Brazilian Fried Rice Fritters**

Put the water and the rice in a pot and bring it to a boil. Cook it until the water is disappeared. Now mix the rice with milk, egg onion, scallion, parsley, backing powder, parmesan, flour and 1 teaspoon salt. You can add more flour to the mixture if it isn't stiff enough to form shapes. Pour in oil in a big pot. So that it is almost full. Bring it to 180degrees. Now you shape the mixture into little balls. Fry the balls for three to four minutes until they are golden brown. Put them on kitchen roll and drain them. Serve them warm and maybe garnish them with fresh parsley.

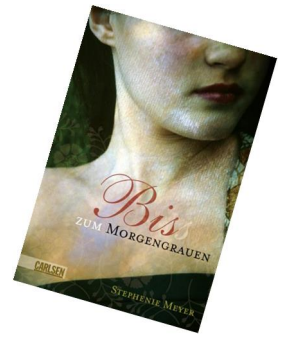

## Sea Devil & Sea Horse

**Would you like to know what a sea devil is? Or which other fish swim like the seahorse vertical? Then you really should read this article about the sea horse and the sea devil!**

Sea devils have a big flat head and no scales. They have big, sharp and strong teeth in their mouth. The sea devil can grow up to 2 metres long and they can weigh up to 50 kg, but most of them grow just up to one metre. The maximum proven age is 24 years. The sea devils live at the bottom of the sea at a depth of 20 to 1000 metres.



At the bottom they hide in sand or in seaweed. These fish have many filaments along the head. These filaments help the sea devil attract their prey. Then the fish seize them. Sea devils are known for swallowing other fish of their own size. These fish spawn approximately 1 million purple eggs from April to June. The sea devil is also a delicacy.

Sea horses are also fish, but they look different than other fish. Their head looks a little bit like a horse and the body like a worm. Sea horses live in all tropic seas, but most live in Australia. They live in sea grass or coral reefs. Their size is between 1,5cm and 35,5cm. These fish have bones and no scales and they have a thin skin stretched over their bone plates. Razor fish are the only other fish that swim vertically like the seahorse. Sea horses have long snouts to suck up food and their eyes can move independently of each other (like those of chameleons). Male sea horses carry nearly up to 1500 eggs for 9 to 45 days until they are fully developed. Sea horses are also sold as street food in China.
