Joanne K. Rowling was born in July 1965 in a hospital. She grew up in Chapstow . (England) She went to the Exeter University and married in 1992. Her daughter Jessica was born in 1993. When her marriage ended she moved to Edinburgh with her daughter where Harry Potter and the Philosophers stone was first completed. She started writing Harry Potter in a delayed train journey. The book was first published by Bloomsbury children`s books in 1997 under the authors name : J. K. Rowling. The K stood for Kathleen (her Grandmother`s name) because the publisher said a lot more boys would read it if they didn't know a women wrote it. Now J.K. Rowling is a famous author who has won many awards. There are 7 Harry Potter books as well as eight films. She has written other books as well, for example: The Tales of Beedle the Bard was published on the 8th of December 2008, to go along with the Harry Potter books. She has also written adult books...



The Harry Potter books have been translated in to around 70 languages.



Water Erosion

What is water erosion?

Water erosion is when rock is worn away by water. There are different types of erosion. Here are a few:

Rainfall erosion: This is when a raindrop falls and it creates a crack in the soil, and soil parts are injected. Now, the raindrop erosion has three types of erosions:

Sheet erosions: The transport of injected soil parts

Rill erosions: When the rain makes a small flow/stream

Gully erosions: The rain makes a narrow channel, removing quite a depth of soil

Glaciers:

Glaciers are worn down in three different ways:

Abrasion/Scouring: Debris of the glaciers polish or break down pieces of it

Plucking: Glaciers cause bedrock to chisel off

Ice Thrusting: Glaciers freeze to their beds and as they surge forward, they break pieces of frozen rocks



Freezing and Thawing: This is when water gets into a tiny crack in the rock, and freezes. And this causes rocks to break off and, in case of mountains, fall. This is dangerous when roads are along sides of the mountain. People put nets there to catch the rocks and in these times the road is often closed.

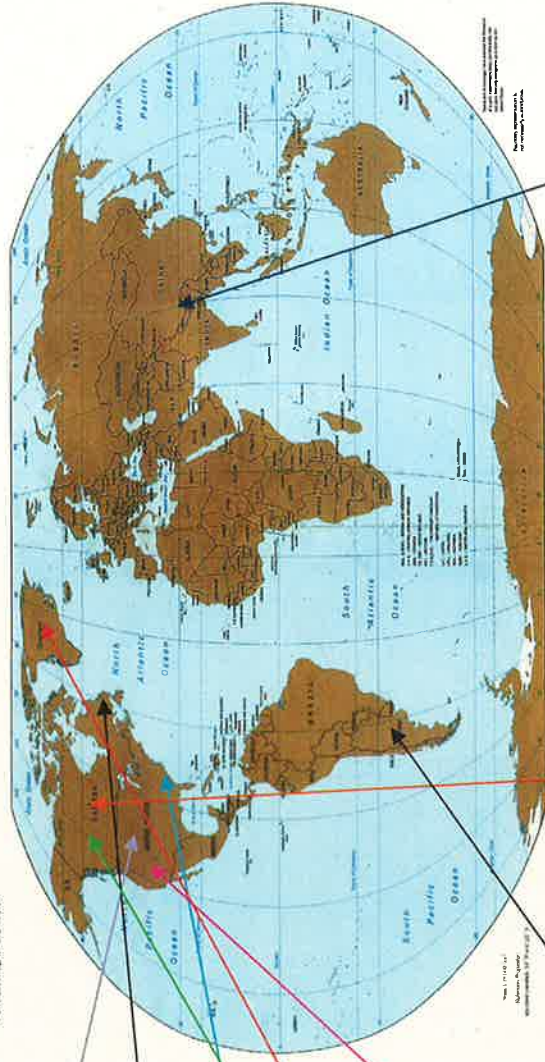

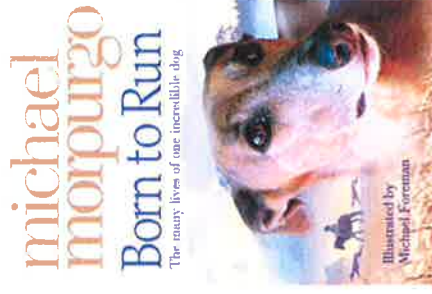

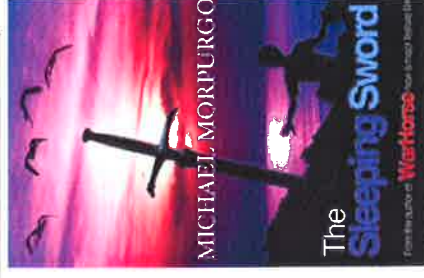
BORN TO RUN

SHADOW

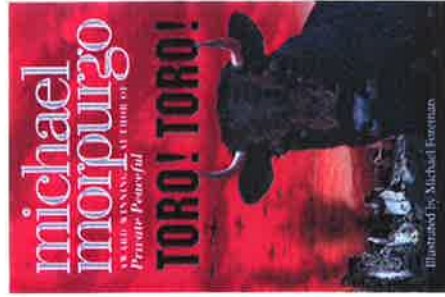

Number left: There are only around 1000-5000 left.

Extra facts:

- 1) They can reach other trees by jumping even if they are a few meters apart.
- 2) They live in small families, if two encounter one another lemurs can become very aggressive.
- 3) The young are born from August to October
- 4) In the wild they live from 18-20 years (in captivity around 26)
- 5) They eat fruits, flowers ,leaves and nectar and bugs
- 6) It`s the size of a small house cat and weighs around 2kg

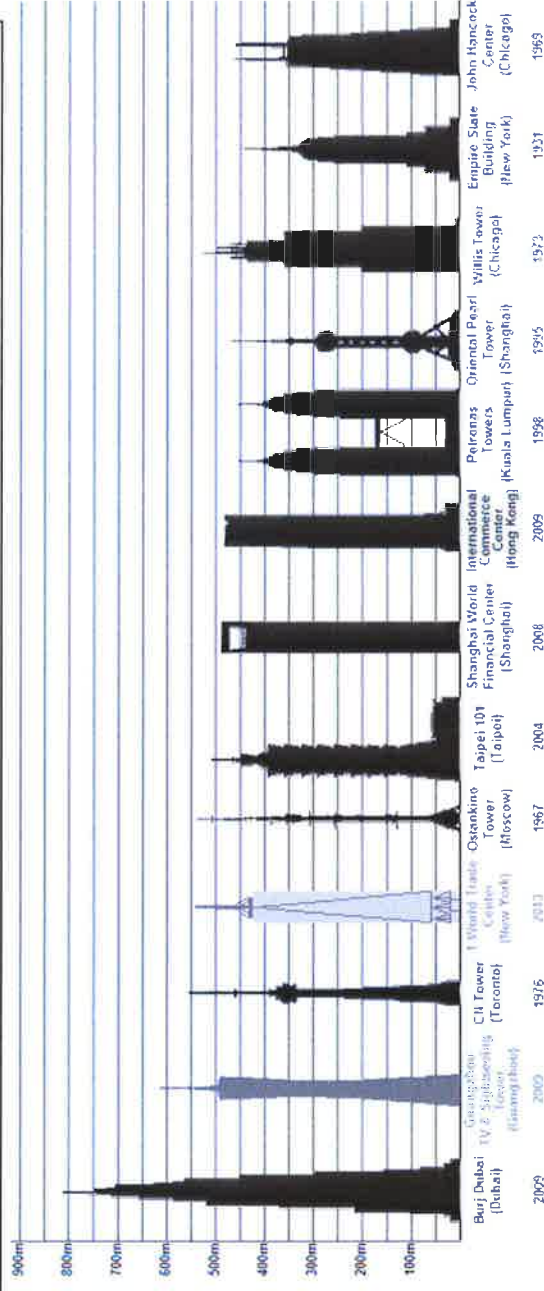

The tallest towers in the world... Did you notice that the buildings are getting higher every year?

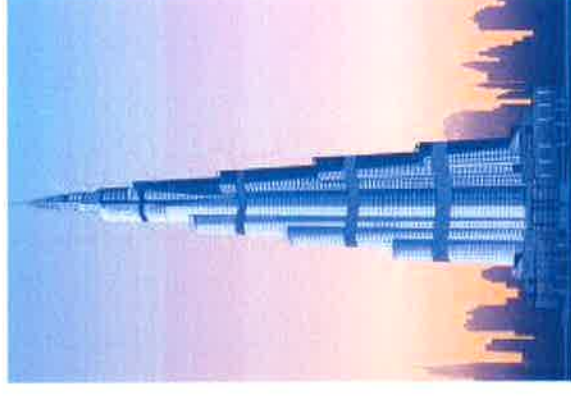


Towers Today

Burj Khalifa

Since April 2008 the Burj Khalifa is the tallest building in the world. It took only 4 years to build it which is really not a long time for such a great building. The tower is also very useful because it has 163 floors to use. This building is almost as tall as 3 times the Eiffel tower, twice as tall as the Empire State building and almost eight times as tall as the pyramid Cheops in Giza. Its "roots" are deeper under the sea level than 70m. 2909 steps lead into the 160 floor and the elevator is 36 km/h fast

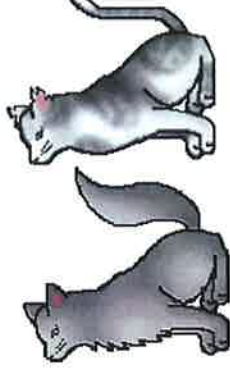


Bramblestar

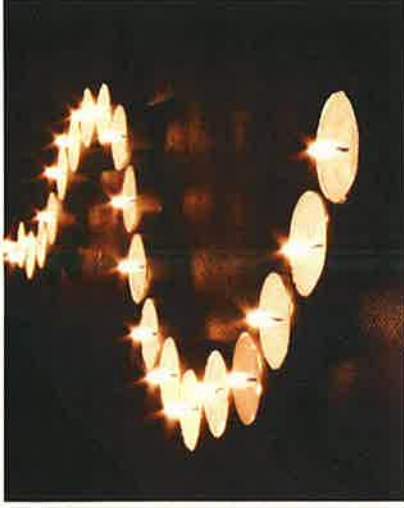

My Top 2 Lanterns



Paper cup Candles:

These are rather easy candles to make. You can add food coloring for extra color and for the wick you can use cotton string. What you need:

- milk carton/paper cup (for the mold)
 - wax/old candle stubs
 - wick(cotton twist:see above)
- Utensils:
- a double boiler which consists (besteht aus) of 2 pots, 1 for each candle
 - tongs
 - Tape or hot glue
 - Pencils/straws/two sticks (for holding the wick straight while the candle is hardening)
 - Low tray or backing pan

Make the candle:

- I. Set out newspapers and get mold ready, trim wick so it is longer than the mold and attach to bottom of the mold. Then tie the wick to a pencil and lay the pencil on the mold
- II. Fill the bottom of the double boiler with an inch or 2 of water, put wax in upper boiler. Save some wax for later!!
- III. As the wax melts, pour it into the molds. Leave an inch free!
- IV. After 20 min or so, take a stick and poke holes next to the wick (to get rid of air bubbles)
- V. Pour the leftover wax over the holes
- VI. After 4 hours or so, untie wick from pencil, cut the paper cup or rip it off, and trim the wick to the size you want.

Lava Lamp

Lava lamps were popular to buy ever since it was invented in 1964. They are relaxing to watch, but the chemicals are poisonous. Here the lava lamp is safe, but still don't swallow contents (tastes disgusting!) What do you need:

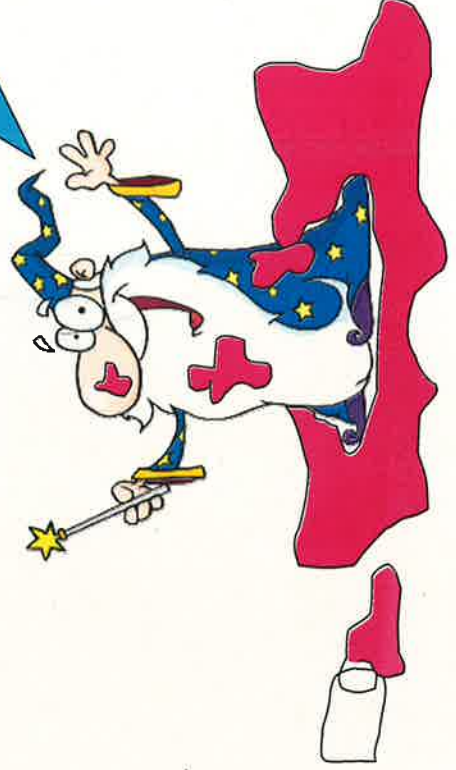
- baby oil
- food coloring
- foaming antacid tablets (Brausetabletten)
- water
- glass jar with a lid

How to make:

- Fill 2 thirds of the jar with oil and the rest with water (but not to the brim!)
- Add a few drops of food coloring
- Break the tablet (Brausetablette) into 6-8 pieces
- Drop 1 or 2 pieces into the jar and close it.
- When it stops, shake the jar (with the lid) and add a few more pieces
- Watch: To light it up use your flashlight or desk lamp
