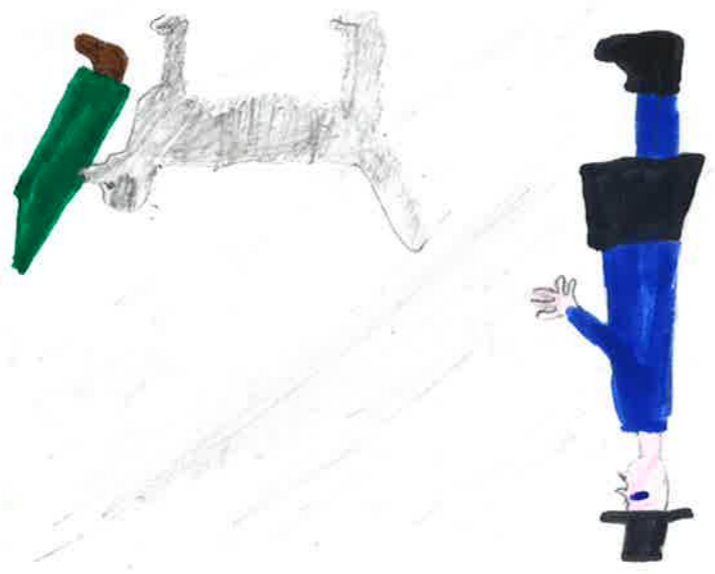
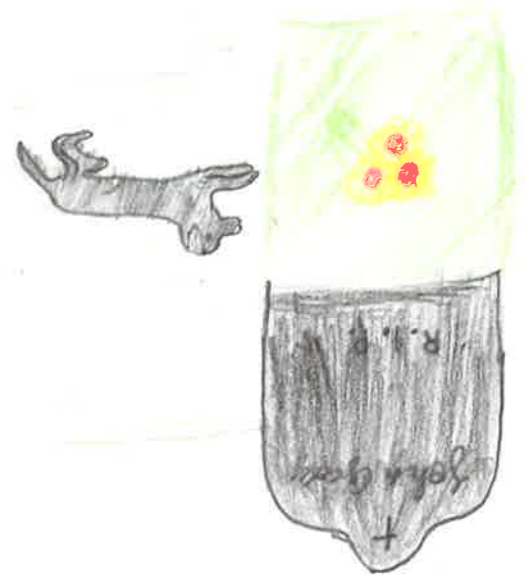
At Home
