"Come with me I have something for you" she said and Karlo followed her to an old grey shop and she went into it.

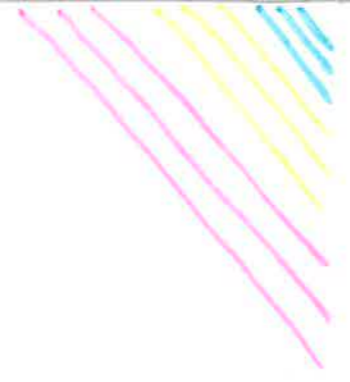
