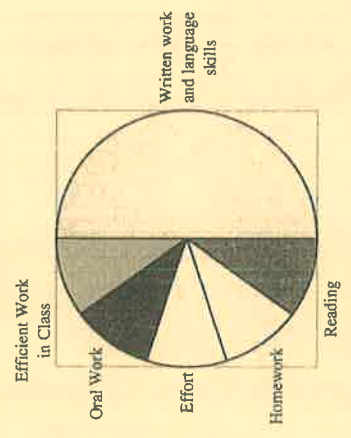

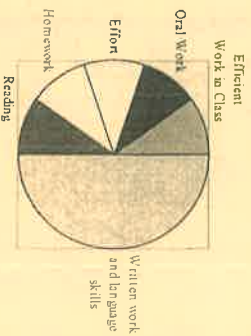

I'd like to give you a ② but I would need to see your grammar book and your writing observation report. Otherwise it's a 3!

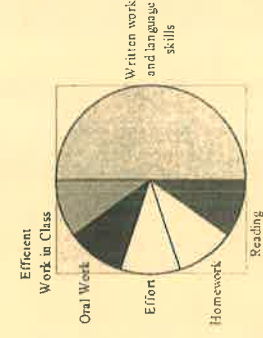
